

Staying safe when coming into school.

Following recent guidance, there are changes to school procedures which pupils coming into school for practical activities should be aware of.





Personal hygiene.

Face coverings: All pupils should wear face coverings in corridors and in classrooms.

Hand hygiene: Pupils should apply hand sanitiser when they enter and leave any area of the school.

Cleaning work surfaces: pupils should wipe down their personal desk space at the start of the day and after lunch.

Social distancing.

Recent guidance states that 2 metre distancing should be put in place for all secondary-aged pupils.

In classrooms, all pupils will be allocated specific seats for the day they are in school. These seats will be 2 metres apart.

2 metre social distancing should also be observed on school transport.

The school day.

The school day begins at 8.30am and pupils should arrive on time and in their school uniform.

Pupils should enter through the main reception doors and go directly to a designated seat in the assembly hall. Pupils will be collected by their class teacher.
