Following updated guidance, there will be some changes to our school procedures for keyworker and vulnerable children.





Personal hygiene.

Face coverings: All BGE pupils should wear face coverings in corridors. All Senior Pupils should wear face coverings in corridors and in classrooms.

Hand hygiene: Pupils should apply hand sanitiser when they enter and leave any area of the school.

Cleaning work surfaces: pupils will continue to wipe down personal desk spaces at the start of the day and after lunch.

Social distancing.

Recent guidance states that 2 metre distancing should be put in place for all secondary-aged pupils. This means existing school procedures will be different.

In classrooms, all pupils will continue to be allocated specific seats for each day they are in school. These seats will be 2 metres apart.

Pupils will now take break and lunchtimes in their classrooms. Our cafeteria is still available to order food from.

2 metre social distancing should be observed on school transport.

The school day.

The school day begins at 8.30am and pupils should arrive on time and in their school uniform.

Pupils should continue to enter and exit through the pupil entrance and use the hand sanitizer provided when they do so.

In classrooms, the online timetable will continue under the supervision of a member of staff. Break and lunchtimes remain the same.
