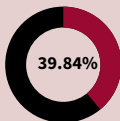


BATHGATE ACADEMY

What are we doing at Bathgate Academy?

School Uniform and Agreed Dress Code

Uniform banks and Clothing Grants are available and supported by the school. Bathgate Quarter has a range of uniform available at all time accessible and free. Sports clothin is also available for PE.

Our Curriculum

There is no additional cost for any aspect of our curriculum, including access to practical subjects such as HE and CDT. Study Support and Easter school are free and available to all.

Learning Resources

We can provide learning packs to ensure pupils have access to essential educational resources, supporting their learning in and out with the classroom.

Access to food and transport

Our canteen offers a range of healthy and affordable food throughout the day. A cashless system ensures those in receipt of FSM are not identified. Students are supported to apply for Young Scot cards for free travel.

Self Care Kits

These are available to any young person to support wellbeing and ensure our students have access to essential hygiene and personal care items.

School Trips & School Clubs

All extra-curricular clubs at lunchtime and after school are free for all students. Our excursion policy ensures reasonable costs and a clear payment schedule for all trips, including a number of free/subsidised spaces.

Events and Charities

Dress down days are limited to once a term and any financial contribution is voluntary. Students may plan additional events to raise funds for school projects and charities. Participation and financial contribution is voluntary.
